**Re: 30-Day Notice of Delta Air Lines, Inc.
(Code-Sharing with Korean Air Lines Co. Ltd.)**

Dear Mr. Gretch:

Pursuant to the blanket Statement of Authorization granted to Delta Air Lines, Inc. ("Delta") and Korean Air Lines Co. Ltd. ("KAL") on August 6, 1998, Delta hereby notifies the Department that Delta intends to begin listing its "DL" designator code on flights operated by KAL between Seoul, Korea and each of the points listed in Exhibit A, beginning on or about September 15, 1998.

Delta's proposed third-country code-share services to Japan via Seoul (which will be offered on a blind-sector basis) are consistent with Part IV-D of the March 14, 1998 Memorandum of Understanding between the United States and Japan ("MOU"). The MOU does not place any frequency or capacity limitations on the third-country code-share operations of non-incumbent carriers. Thus, no limited-entry authority is involved to the points named in Exhibit A.
