
NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL, WITHOUT PREJUDICE,
OF NOTICE TO TERMINATE SERVICE

Mesa Air Group, Inc., on behalf of its subsidiary, CCAIR, Inc., d/b/a US Airways Express, respectfully withdraws its notice to terminate service, OST 2002-11348-1, at Athens, Georgia. Mesa Air Group, Inc. intends to continue service, following the June 17, 2002, hold-in period, between Athens, Georgia and Charlotte, North Carolina, without request for federal subsidy under the Essential Air Service program.

Mesa Air Group, Inc. advises the Department of Transportation that Air Midwest, Inc., a wholly owned subsidiary of Mesa Air Group, began providing the replacement service for the CCAIR, Inc. route between Athens, Georgia and Charlotte, North Carolina on April 15, 2002. Air Midwest, Inc., will operate three daily roundtrips using Beech 1900 aircraft, under a US Airways codeshare agreement, between Athens, Georgia and Charlotte, North Carolina.
